Danish System of Judging

Exhibitors must have carry cages for their entries. Cages will not be provided. Cages must have solid bottoms & be leak proof. No carriers will be available to bring the animals to the tables. Exhibitors are expected to be on hand during judging to bring their animals to the judging tables. Exhibit will not be judged if exhibitor misses his or her call to bring rabbits to the table. Only youth exhibitors may carry animals to the judging table. All small animals will be housed on grounds for the duration of the fair, their release date will be Sunday, July 24 at 6pm. Junior rabbit & poultry must be checked in by a junior exhibitor, or entry will not be accepted. Only the 4-H & FFA Champions will sell in the auction at the Rabbit & Poultry Meat Pens.

JUNIOR RABBIT

All rabbits entered as specific breeds will be judged by the rules of the American Rabbit Breeders Association. A meat pen consists of three rabbits minimum of 3 pounds or 70 days old. All rabbits must have permanent ear tattoo & corresponds to the entry form. **NO FELT MARKING will be acceptable for ear tattoos.**

Special Awards:

Best of Show, Reserve Best of Show, Champion Meat Pen, Reserve Meat Pen, Best DQ or Backyard Bunny, Best Cavy.
