All Open & Jr. Livestock must be on grounds by 5pm, Tuesday, July 19th. **All Sheep and Goats must go through a Health Inspection prior to unloading from livestock trailers and or vehicles. Exhibitor information will be logged for reference purposes once the exhibitor's animals have been checked. Cattlemen's Lawn is the official Health Check Area. Exhibitors who bypass the health inspection and unload their animals in their designated pens will be disqualified from the livestock show and must remove their animals from the grounds immediately.**

All Junior Livestock Exhibitors

Pre-Fair Livestock Meeting, July 19 immediately following weigh-in in the Judging Pavilion. All exhibitors (junior & open divisions) are required to attend the exhibitor meeting following the official weigh-ins unless prior arrangements are made & recorded with Lassen County Fair Office. Failure to attend will result in a Red Tag. See Red Tag Policy on page 18.
