NEW-Exhibitors must provide proof of Tuberculosis testing for all breeding cattle over six months of age with ONE of the following documents:

1) signed documentation from a licensed accredited veterinarian of a negative TB test obtained within the sixty days prior to exhibition of all dairy breeding cattle to be sold or,

2) signed documentation from a licensed accredited veterinarian of a negative TB test obtained within six months prior to exhibition of all dairy breeding cattle for exhibition only, or:

3) signed documentation from a licensed accredited veterinarian of a negative whole herd test for the animal's herd of origin (i.e., the herd where the animal has resided for a minimum 4 month period of time immediately prior to the exhibition) obtained within the twelve months prior to the exhibition, or

4) A letter from CDFA verifying the completion date of a negative whole herd test for TB and specifying the official identification for exhibition animals from the herd.

RULES: All rabbits must be identified by a permanent ear tattoo matching that on the entry form. A numbered leg band must identify all poultry. The leg band number must match that on the entry form. Poultry inspection will be performed prior to coup. From 4–6pm July 19, 2011. This is an Open Rabbit Show. The Poultry Show is a cooped show. All small animals will be housed on grounds for the duration of the fair, their release date will be Sunday, July 24 at 5pm. All entered as specific breeds will be judged by the rules of the American Rabbit Breeders Association & American Poultry Standard or Perfection. No carriers will be available to bring the animals to the tables. Exhibitors are expected to be on hand during judging to bring their animals to the judging tables. Junior Rabbits & Poultry must be checked in by a junior exhibitor, or entry will not be accepted.
